Ring One

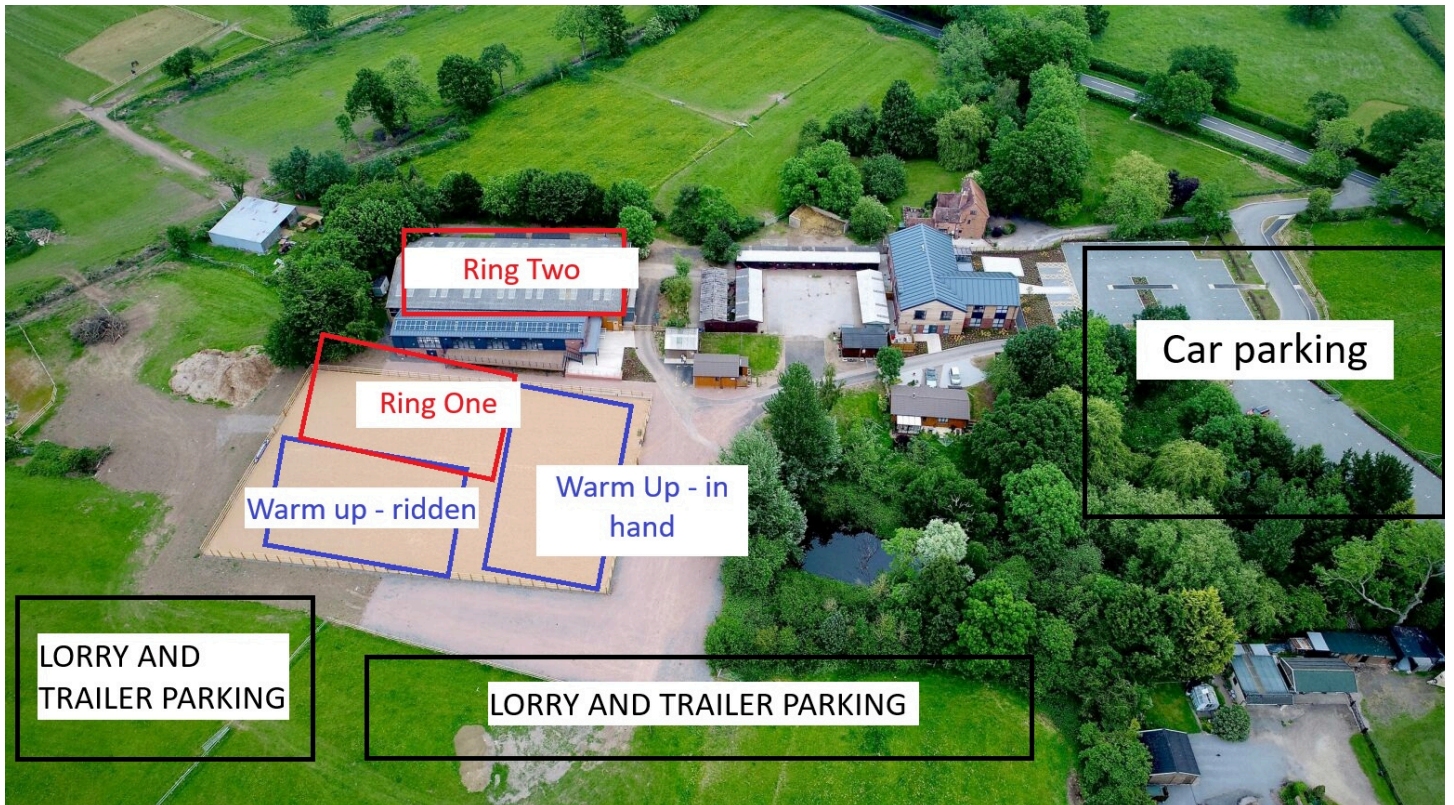
Outdoor Arena: Classes 1 to 4 and Classes 13 to 18

Ring Two

ICAP Indoor Arena: Classes 5 to 12 (EquiFest Qualifying Classes)

Entries: pre entry £12.00 or £15.00 on the day

Show Rules

By entering a Class you are agreeing to follow our Show Rules

1. All attending must be kind and courteous to other competitors, volunteers, judges and staff members. We have a zero-tolerance policy on bullying and expect all attending to follow the rules.
2. The organisers & landowners do not accept any liability for damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators, or personal property.
3. Hard hats to current BSI Standards must be worn at all times when mounted.
4. The Organisers reserve the right to alter, add to or cancel any class, and to refuse any entry without stating a reason.
5. No Misuse of the whip, spurs or equipment will be allowed.
6. All horses/ponies must have had a flu vaccination within 12 months of the competition and not within the 7 days prior to the event. Please be aware you will need to bring your horse's passport to be able to compete on the day or you can send a copy via email to dhookins@rda.org.uk

7. Horses/Ponies must be 4yrs old and over for ridden classes
8. No horse/pony will be permitted to compete in more than 5 classes on the day (excluding Championship classes)
9. Horses must not be left unattended whilst tied up to your lorry/trailer.
10. Horses/ponies are not permitted to be warmed up or exercised in the lorry and trailer parking areas, this includes groundwork such as lungeing.
11. Please dispose of any loose hay and droppings in the wheelbarrows provided.
12. All dogs must be kept on the lead at ALL TIMES whilst on site
13. We are a non smoking site and vaping is only permitted at the bike shelter in front of main RDA office building.

Start at 9.00am

Class 1 – Best Turned Out Open to any horse or pony In hand or Ridden

Class 2 – Open Youngstock In hand, open to any breed or type, 1, 2 or 3 year old

Class 3 – Thoroughbred/Ex Racer In Hand open to any age

Class 4 – Best Condition, any breed or type In hand or Ridden

Championship 1st and 2nd place from class 1 to 4 to go forward

Ring One

Classes not to start before 1:00pm

Class 13 - Best Mane & Tail judge is looking for an amazing set of locks, glossy and full, any height, any age, any colour, just lots of mane and tail! Lead rein, ridden, in hand all accepted in the class.

Class 14 - Best Thelwell Lookalike ridden ponies can be led or off the lead rein, or shown in -hand

Class 15 - Prettiest Mare judge is looking for a stand out mare who turns heads, any height, any colour can be shown in hand or under saddle, led or ridden off lead rein.

Class 16 - Most Handsome Gelding judge is looking for a handsome Gelding who turns heads, any height, any colour can be shown in hand or under saddle, led or ridden off lead rein.

Class 17 - Judge would most like to take home judge will make the impossible decision on which pony or horse they'd like to take home! Good luck to them

Class 18 - Fancy Dress Horse or Pony must be included, no theme but the judge wants to see something CREATIVE, IMAGINATIVE and FUN!

Championship Class 1st and 2nd place from classes 1 to 4 and 13 to 18 to go forward to the championship for Champion and Reserve placing.

EQUIFEST This Show is affiliated to Equifest, taking place at Arena UK Ltd, Allington Lane, Allington, Lincolnshire, NG32 2EF on the 5th – 8th August 2026. The two highest exhibits not already qualified in each affiliated class will qualify.

Class 5 – Equifest Open Mountain & Moorland In Hand

Open to In Hand Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A, B, C and D. Stallion, Mare, Colt, Filly or Gelding, any age. Classes may be divided according to entries into Small and Large Breeds

Class 6 – Open Lead Rein - Open to both Mountain & Moorland & Show Ponies

Open to Mares or Geldings 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cm (12.2hh). Rider not to have attained their 9th birthday before 01st January in the current year. Must be shown in a snaffle bridle, with lead rein attached to the noseband only. The Leader / Attendant must be a competent person aged 14 years or older

Please note: Equifest Mountain & Moorland Lead Rein & First Ridden: Open to registered Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland and Welsh A or B ponies

Class 7 – Equifest Open Mountain & Moorland Ridden

Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A, B, C and D. Stallion, Mare or Gelding,

4 years old and over. Rider any age. Classes may be divided according to entries into Small and Large Breeds

1st and 2nd placed from classes 5 to 7 to go forward to the championship class which will be held after Class 12.

Ring Two

Classes not to start before 12:30pm

Class 8 - Equifest Re-Trained Racehorses

Open to former Thoroughbred Racehorses to showcase their retraining and suitability as a Riding Horse. Class is open to Thoroughbred Mares or Geldings, 4 years old and over, of any height, that have been trained for or raced in Great Britain

Class 9- Equifest In-Hand Piebald / Skewbalds

Open to horses and ponies aged 4 years and over, both Native / Traditional types or Hogged / Cob types

Class 10 - Equifest Ridden Piebald / Skewbald's

Open to horses and ponies aged 4 years and over, rider any age, both Native / Traditional types or Plaited / Hogged / Cob types

Class 11- Equifest In Hand Veteran

Open to both horses and ponies 15 years and over, any breed, height or colour

Class 12 -Equifest Ridden Veteran

Open to both horses and ponies 15 years and over, any breed, height or colour, rider any age

Championship Class 1st and 2nd place from classes 8 to 12 to go forward to the championship for Champion and Reserve placing.
